

2025 Stateline Speedway Enduro Rules

1. Eligibility

- a. Open to any American or Foreign passenger car or minivan.
- b. Driver must be at least 16 years of age and provide an ID to receive a Driver's armband.
- c. No racing parts, with the exception of safety equipment.

2. Engine & Drivetrain

- a. 4- and 6-Cylinder engines Only.
- b. Engine must be stock for make and model of Car.
- c. 2 Wheel Drive cars and vans only No All-Wheel Drive Allowed.

3. Tires & Wheels

- a. Must be stock for make and model of the car.
- b. No racing tires, No Truck tires (including Lite Duty Truck) allowed of any kind.
- c. DOT tires only no chains or studded tires.
- d. Tires must be the same size on both sides of the car, and front to back.

4. Safety

- a. Working seat belts are required, racing belts are recommended.
- b. Gloves are required.
- c. Fire-retardant clothing, fire suits, are highly recommended.
- d. A year 2000 or newer Snell approved helmet is required.
- e. All glass, lights, moldings must be removed.
- f. Mirrors and windows must be removed completely.
- g. Windshield if optional. A maximum of ½" wire mesh must be installed in the windshield area if removed.
- h. Seats must be fastened solid to the floor.
- i. Gas tank may be in the original position or strapped in the trunk with at least (4) one-inch straps.
- j. A Firewall must remain between the driver compartment and trunk.
- k. No bars through the firewall (1 $\frac{1}{2}$ inch x 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ inch rub rails tight to the body are OK).
- I. Batteries must be located in the engine compartment or may be on the passenger side floor covered with rubber mats.
- m. Sunroofs & T-Tops must be securely covered by no less than 3/16th steel.
- n. Roll bars are optional but recommended.

5. Frame & Body

- a. No alteration or reinforcement of car frames or body of any kind, except for the rub rails as described in Section 7.J above.
- b. No cutting or gutting of any panels will be permitted.
- c. No bracing in front of front firewall.
- d. Cars must have full bodies.
- e. Trunks, hoods, hatchbacks, and doors must be fastened shut by chaining or welding.

6. General

- a. Cars must be numbered on both sides; number height must be a minimum of 16" tall.
- b. Shark fins (sign on top of roof) with your registered number are mandatory.
- c. Cars found to be illegal will not receive entry fee back and will be disqualified
- d. Cars must be removed from the track property within 24 hours of the end of the race or will become property of Stateline Speedway.
- e. All cars are required to pit in the designated pit area.
- f. No alcohol allowed in the pit area.
