

Tech Update Bulletin – 10/6/2025

The following questions have come in from competitors for the upcoming Stateline 200 on October 25th. See Q's and A's below. Email <u>info@statelinespeedway.com</u> or through FB messenger with any additional questions.

- Q: Can I use a Subaru AWD as long as the Rear or Front are disabled
- A: Yes, as long as there is no possible way to hook it back up. We will make this determination in tech.
- Q. How will scoring work, are we using transponders?
- A: No, transponders will not be used. We do not have enough transponders to outfit the whole field. Competitors must bring a scorer. Scorers will be seated behind the flag stand. Stateline will confirm scoring throughout the race with competitor scorers.
- Q: What is the starting time for the enduro?
- A: Starting time for the enduro is 2PM.
- Q: Should we put a number on our car or will numbers be assigned at the track?
- A: Numbers will be assigned at the track based on the Starting Draw. For example, the car starting 1st will be #1. This is to avoid duplicate numbers and the difficulty of scoring potentially over 100 cars.



Ų:	Are nood pins acceptable?
A:	Yes, they are acceptable.
Q:	Are racing wheels allowed?
A:	No, only the stock production wheels for the make/model/year of car are allowed.
Q:	What can we use for rub rails?
A:	A maximum 1% x 1% square or round tubing (rub rail) may used on the Driver's AND passenger side. Rub rails must be securely bolted with washers to the body by a minimum of (4) bolts per rub rail.
Q:	Can we run a rear-wheel drive as long as its 2-wheel drive?
A:	Yes, any 4 or 6 cylinder passenger car or mini van can be used as long as it's a 2-wheel drive vehicle. NO TRUCKS or Jeeps.
Q:	Can we run a bar between the pillars behind the seat?
A:	Yes, this is permitted. "Roll bars are optional but recommended"
Q:	The car I am using has had a front end impact and the radiator support is gone.
A:	You may build a radiator support to provide additional support.



- Q: Are challenger cars legal to run in the Enduro
- A: No, a challenger car has likely had too many modifications and is not allowed to run in the enduro.
- Q: Are we allowed to strip the interior, seats, carpet, inner door panels?
- A: Yes, it is not only allowed it is highly recommended as a safety concern.
- Q: Can we run studded tires?
- A: No studded tires of any kind are permitted.
- Q: How many positions does Starting Draw apply to?
- A: Starting draw applies to all starting positions.
- Q: Is there a maximum number of cars that will start the race?
- A: No, there is not maximum to the number of cars that can start the race.
